

Mission, Philosophy, Standards



Mission

Philosophy

- Providing an open, safe, fun, positive environment for players to learn, develop, and feel good about their individual and collective achievements
- Heavily concentrating on the mastery of basic skills (Tools of the Game)
- Teaching of principles and philosophies of the game (Knowledge of the Game)
- Stressing the value and importance of teamwork
- Teaching the importance of accountability, how to be held accountable, and how to hold others accountable
- Instilling a love of healthy competition
- Demonstrating great sportsmanship



Standards

BEHAVIOR AND ENVIRONMENT - Respectful, Christian, Sportsmanlike behavior is expected at all times, even on social media. Cheer positively for all players, thank the referees and volunteers. Follow Mom's advice - if you don't have something nice to say, don't say it. Misbehavior can result in significant individual consequences.

PLAYING TIME - Playing time is not equal. Discussions of playing time between parents and coaches are strictly prohibited. Players should address questions about playing time directly with their coach.

48 HOUR RULE - If you are upset about anything, you must wait at least 48 hours to contact any coach or board member to discuss it - RESPECT THE CHAIN OF COMMUNICATION

NASTYGRAMS - Nastygrams will be politely ignored. We will be happy to discuss any issues you may have. However, you must call or make other arrangement to discuss them.

CONCUSSIONS - We will error on the side of caution. <u>ALWAYS</u>. If your daughter is removed because of a suspected concussion, she will need medical clearance to return to play.

CYO & OTHER ACTIVITIES - Conflicts are to be clearly communicated well in advance with your coach. Be sure you understand what the effects of missed practices and games will be when making decisions about conflicts.

Standards

TIMELINESS - Please do your best to be on time to practice, games, and volunteer responsibilities.

GYM ETIQUETTE -

- · If possible, wait in the hall until the previous team has completed. If not, stay out of the way and quiet during other practice times.
- · If you are staying, please respect that you should not be speaking while coaches are speaking. Be mindful of siblings.
- End on time, and vacate the gym quickly. (Change in the halls.)
- · Clean up. Leave it better than you found it.
